RULES AND PROCEDURES

Please read the rules and procedures carefully and retain these sheets for your records. Due to space, only a limited number of entries will be accepted into the competition. You are encouraged to submit your entry form early to ensure entry into the competition. The City of Newberry Parks, Recreation, and Tourism Department reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed inappropriate. INDIVIDUAL ENTERING & QUALIFYING GUIDELINES

To be eligible for the competition, a completed and signed copy of the Competitor Entry Form must be received by email or mail prior to 5 pm on November 25. The Competitor Entry Form must be signed by the individual entering the competition. If the individual is under the age of 18 on the date of the competition, a signature from a parent or legal guardian is required in addition to the minor's signature and date of birth. Competitors will receive a confirmation email upon receipt of completed Competitor Entry Form. Only one entry per person will be accepted.

TEAM ENTERING & QUALIFYING GUIDELINES

To be eligible for the competition, a completed and signed copy of the Competitor Entry Form and the Team Entry Participant Form must be received by email or mail prior to 5 pm on November 25. Please submit one completed copy of Competitor Entry Form per team including only the team captain's contact information. Please submit a list of all team participants using Team Entry Participant Form. A signature from a parent or legal guardian will be required for each team member under 18 years of age. In the event a team entry wins a prize, the team captain will be the recipient of any prizes. Distribution of ribbon or splitting of any prize will be left to the team captain to determine. We are not able to supply ribbons for each participant.

CANCELLATION POLICY

We understand that situations may cause competitors to withdraw from the competition. In the event you are unable to compete, please inform The City of Newberry Parks, Recreation, and Tourism Department by phone 803-321-1015 as soon as possible.

DESIGN

Entries are not limited to the structure of a house. Competitors are welcome and encouraged to uniquely design their entry for the competition, if the entry is in keeping with the competition rules and procedures and the five judging criteria.

JUDGING AND CRITERIA

Judging will be held on December 3 at 7pm. The awards will be given on December 5. Entries will be judged on 1) Overall Appearance, 2) Originality & Creativity, 3) Difficulty, 4) Precision and 5) Consistency of Theme. Theme should be competitor's own and consistent throughout the entry. Your theme will be determined by your competition entry title (at the discretion of the judges). Entries should be original designs by the competitor. Although imitation is "the greatest form of flattery," judges will be looking for original entries. Decorative elements that are handmade will carry more weight than similar prefabricated items. All rulings by the judges are independent and final. In the event of a tie, the competition Call Judge will be asked to break the tie.

ENTRY CATEGORIES

The following categories are open for entry into the 2020 A Very Berry Christmas Gingerbread Competition **Please note there is limited entry for both competitions- apply early to ensure your space:**

NEWBERRY VILLAGE COMPETITION ENTRY RULES:

- Newberry Village: Open to all ages, teams, or individuals (Limited to 10 Entries)

SIZE LIMITATIONS

- Entry must be placed on a board base.
- Entries combined with a base must not be larger than 24 inches high, 24 inches wide, and 24 inches long.
 - We suggest using ½” or ¾” plywood as a base for your entry. Use of pegs or risers on the bottom of the base is preferred but not required. If you wish to install “legs” on the underside of your base, the legs are considered as part of the base and should not cause the entry’s height to exceed 24 inches.

MATERIALS & CONSTRUCTION

- Everything above the base of your entry must be constructed and composed completely of edible materials.
- At least 75% of the main structure of your entry must be constructed of *homemade* gingerbread, some of which should be exposed. Purchased/prefabricated gingerbread will not be accepted.
- Edible materials are not limited to candies and icings. Use of gum paste, fondant, pastillage, chocolate, modeling chocolate, royal icing, isomalt, cast sugar, gelatin, and pressed sugar is encouraged.
- No artificial display materials, such as Styrofoam or interior lighting, are to be used in the construction or decoration of the entry.
- Candies must be unwrapped, however non-edible materials that come as part of the candy are allowed, for example: lollipop sticks.
- Non-edible materials such as paint and/or ribbon are approved (and encouraged) to decorate the outer edge of your plywood base only (not to exceed the length and/or width of the base).
- All entries must be solely constructed by the individual(s) entering the competition.

KIDS VILLAGE COMPETITION ENTRY RULES:

- Kids' Village: Open to children ages 6 to 16 (Limited to 10 Entries)

SIZE LIMITATIONS

- Entry must be placed on a board base.
- Entries combined with a base must not be larger than 12 inches high, 12 inches wide, and 12 inches long (NO LARGER PLEASE). Please note these constructions are to be smaller than that of the Newberry Village entries.
 - We suggest using ½" or ¾" plywood as a base for your entry. Use of pegs or risers on the bottom of the base is preferred but not required. If you wish to install "legs" on the underside of your base, the legs are considered as part of the base and should not cause the entry's height to exceed 12 inches.

MATERIALS & CONSTRUCTION

- Everything above the base of kids' entries must be constructed and composed completely of edible materials.
- At least 50% of the main structure of your entry must be constructed of gingerbread, some of which should be exposed (homemade is not required for Kids Village entries but is highly encouraged).
- Edible materials are not limited to candies and icings. Get creative! Use cake decorating techniques, crackers, even ice cream cones!
- Due to the danger of working with hot sugar, techniques using poured hot sugar or isomalt are reserved for the Newberry Village Category only.
- No artificial display materials, such as Styrofoam or interior lighting, are to be used in the construction or decoration of the entry.
- Candies must be unwrapped, however non-edible materials that come as part of the candy are allowed, for example: lollipop sticks.
- Non-edible materials such as paint and/or ribbon are approved (and encouraged) to decorate the outer edge of your plywood base only (not to exceed the length and/or width of the base). You may paint the top of your base should you wish, however everything above the base must be edible (please note this rule does NOT include Newberry Village Category, where the top of the base is expected to be decorated with edible materials).
- All entries must be constructed by the individual(s) entering the competition. Teen, Youth, and Child competitors may be supervised, for safety precautions, by a parent, legal guardian, or classroom teacher. Acceptable Supervision Example: When Teen, Youth, or Child competitors require assistance with operating the oven and/or stovetop.

ENTRY DROP-OFF PROCESS

1. UNLOAD your entry at the Newberry Arts Center (1200 Main) from Caldwell Street. You must promptly move your vehicle to a nearby parking area once you have unloaded your entry. Prior to judging, contestant entries are not to be handled by any staff member, so please be sure to bring help!
2. CHECK-IN will be located at the entrance of the Newberry Arts Center at 1200 Main. At check in you will receive a card with the title of your entry. Please place this on your entry upon arrival. Spaces are first come, first served for placement.
3. PHOTOGRAPHY- You and your entry will be photographed for media purposes; mandatory for all competition entries.
4. YOUR ENTRY SHOULD BE COMPLETE prior to your arrival. You may make small adjustments upon placement with the approval of staff, however additional construction of your entry will not be allowed once placed. We ask that all competitors exit the Newberry Arts Center promptly after placing their entry. You are not permitted to view the other entries at this time in order to keep the registration process moving.

2020 GINGERBREAD DISPLAY

Entries will be on display at the Newberry Arts Center during the holiday season, beginning Friday, December 4, 2020, through Wednesday, December 23, 2020. Upon delivery to the Newberry Arts Center at no time is there a guarantee of safety or security of the entry. The City of Newberry Parks, Recreation, & Tourism office, of which the Newberry Arts Center is a part, is not held responsible for any damages incurred by the entry during display. However, precautions will be taken to help ensure the safety of entries during display so they can be fully enjoyed during the holiday season.

DISPLAY VIEWING DAYS

Entries will be displayed in the windows of the Newberry Arts Center for 24-hour enjoyment. Additionally, the Newberry Arts Center will be open during their regular business hours and for special events. Call 803-597-1125 for details.

ENTRY PICK-UP

Competitors that would like to keep their gingerbread entry after the competition display has ended MUST indicate so on their entry form. Pick up of entries will be between the hours of 10am and 3pm on Wednesday, December 23, 2020. All entries left after that time will be discarded.
